## WHAT

We are going to build the "mudLIBRARY", a school library made of mud, with help from international students and locals. You will have the possibility to accompany a sustainable construction project through all phases, experiment with mud as a building material, learn from the experts and get in touch with the local community.

## WHO

## WHERE

The library will be built in Nsutem, a village of approx. 2000 inhabitants situated in the Eastern Region in Ghana. Nsutem is roughly a two-hour drive by bus from Accra, and about half-way on the road to Kumasi, the second biggest city in Ghana. In Nsutem you will stay in a house with the rest of the team, either in a three-bed dorm or in a double room (both have a private bathroom).

## COSTS

For a three week stay, incl. accommodation, board and transportation you have to calculate with about 1200,- €. Every additional week would cost approx. 150,- € extra. ArchFair will take care of the accommodation and board, your visa and transportation is your own responsibility.
